Oil and Gas Waste Pits



Surface waste disposal sites (SWDs) or "waste pits" are open air pits where oil and gas companies dump liquid and solid waste from the oilfield. Material disposed in waste pits may include drill cuttings, spent completion fluid, working fluids, and other oil and gas production waste. Some pits are located on well pads, and others combine waste from surrounding well sites.



Waste pits can sicken nearby community members, contaminate surface and groundwater, release harmful gas, and

poison cattle and wildlife.

Impacted community members largely bear the burden of proving that these facilities harm human and environmental health, when it should be the responsibility of the company and the Railroad Commission of Texas, our state oil and gas agency, to protect Texans from these risks.

Solutions

- Do not allow treated drill cuttings to be used as construction fill or as road base on county roads (45% of the roads in the state).
 - Require liners and setbacks for "authorized" pits used on-lease at oil and gas well sites, and ensure consent from landowners, without exception.
- Standardize and improve groundwater monitoring to prevent leakage or improper handling of waste, which can introduce harmful chemicals and pollutants into drinking water.
